PROJECT ON BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION IN AJ&K



TF signed the Memorandum of Agreement with UNDP-GEF Small Grants Program (SGP) on 30th of November 2017 for the 'Biodiversity Conservation of Qazi Nag Game Reserve'. Our emphasis remains on laying solid foundations for this challenging assignment.

A comprehensive Landscape Strategy is also developed for the focused region and available for review on this website. SGP Pakistan is in its 6th phase and investing in the following fields:

I. Conservation of biodiversity and restoration of ecosystem services in Indus Delta and other areas of Pakistan through rain water harvesting, reforestation, afforestation, agroecological practices, introducing tree banks of resilient indigenous species to increase reforestation, support the interventions that improve soil fertility, mangroves plantation and conservation, introducing energy efficient housing and cooking technologies, liquid and solid waste management, sustainable fisheries, etc. 2. Conservation of rare indigenous livestock breeds in Indus Delta and globally significant wildlife species including Snow Leopard, Woolly Flying Squirrel, Musk Deer, Balochistan Black Bear, Markhor and Urial.

3. Eco-tourism to reducing the burden of unsustainable tourism practices.

4. Demonstration, deployment and transfer of renewable energy and energy efficient technologies and approaches that promote conservation and enhancement of carbon stocks; through fuel efficient technologies, promotion and adoption of energy efficient stoves and kilns, compressed earth blocks, use of solar powered products and trainings for repair and maintenance of solar power products.

ABOUT TF GS ZHOB

Zhob is a small town and district capital of Zhob District in Balochistan. Zhob is located on the banks of Zhob River.

Taaleem Foundation Grammar School was initiated in Zhob in the year 1991. The property for the school was donated by a family trust - Asad Memorial Trust. Additional construction was completed through the support from the provincial government and some generous community leaders. Today, the facility is able to accommodate 700 students. The school comprises of 20 classrooms, multipurpose hall, library, computer center, dispensary and adequate staff residences.



The School has played a vital role in uplifting the literacy rate in the area. The school has been providing quality education for the past 22 years and is the second oldest school in the chain. An education revolution has been initiated between the beautiful and serene flora and fauna of Zhob.

TF GS KILA SAIFULLAH

Killa Saifullah has a population of nearly 250,000 souls. TF Grammar School at Killa Saifullah is housed in a customized building constructed with the Japanese assistance. The school has a capacity to accommodate 600 students. The facility was developed through the support of the local government and the generous support from Japanese Government through JICA. The premise has 24 classrooms, computer lab, good play ground dispensary and adequate accommodation for staff. Killa Saifullah is located at a distance of 180km from Quetta and 420 km from Multan.





AFORESTATION

Afforestation is the establishment of a forest or stand of trees (forestation) in an area where there was no previous tree cover.

ONE CHILD, ONE TREE PROGRAM

The government has devised an innovative plan to generate awareness for greater greenery in the country with its "One Child, One tree" Programme that started this year.

This time the Programme that is meant to involve nursery-going children is an ambitious plan to have them plant a seed and nurture the plant till it grows into a tree.

The idea is to create a bond between children and trees, right from childhood, Environment Minister said, With the 'One child, one tree' Programme the environment ministry plans to start getting children in nursery schools to sow a seed in their schools and have them to nurture the plant individually till the time they remain in nursery classes.

When the same children leave the nursery and move on to proper schools, they will be carrying the plant that they sowed with them and replant it at their homes or anywhere else that they want to and where they can track the growth of the tree.

As the children grow up, the plant will also grow with the same children looking after them. This way by the time a child grows into an adult, he or she is also likely to develop a special bond with the tree that they planted.

The Principals TF School Zhob & Kila Saifullah, while talking to the students on this occasion highlighted the importance of plants in the context of current climate change which in turns, the cause of Global Warming. They also added that our religion also teaches us to plant trees.

They thanked the official of Forest Department for providing 1000 tress showing kind interest and cooperation. Meanwhile the school with help of Syndicate will identify community and local areas where the students can plant the Trees.

Each student has been tasked to plant the tree at his or her family land, take care of it with help of his/her family and nurture the tree so that it can become self-sustainable.











The school will write a diary note for students where parents and families can give written consent on diary that they agree to support their child and helping school make the children socially responsible.

If children and their families will take care of the trees then water management will not be an issue.

In addition, TFGS Board position holders will plant trees with their name plaque.

One tree each year for any child who secures any of 1st three board positions.

Further senior students with teachers also visited F.G High school & Al-Huda school planted trees their & also discussed the importance of trees with the students & teachers of these schools.
